Due to the serious unrest and clashes that occurred within the Negombo Prison on 05<sup>th</sup> and 06<sup>th</sup> July, it is reported that 25 individuals, including prison officials and prisoners, have died and over 100 individuals have been injured. Therefore, the full responsibility for the aforementioned deaths and injuries falls upon the Government.

Accordingly, considering the gravity and urgent nature of this matter, we kindly request you to grant an opportunity for an urgent adjournment debate under Standing Order 19(1) to bring this matter to the urgent attention of Parliament.
